SEU HAS DEVELOPED THE CURRICULUM IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE EUROPEAN STANDARDS

SEU firmly maintains the status of the most demanded private university.

SEU is a university oriented on unceasing development with one of the best campuses in the world, modern academic programs, highly qualified staff and well-developed student services. SEU has fully adapted to the European management and quality assurance standards, which in turn, has led to extensive organisational changes.

SEU has invited experts from the leading German international advisory group on European higher education, whose portfolio includes reforms of educational and research institutions around the world. SEU has been collaborating with them for more than 2 years, and during this time, the university has invested more than 2 million

GEL in organisational development and quality improvement.

Within the framework of this cooperation, both the organisational structure and corporate culture of the university have changed.

The SEU team has grown and staffed with the country's leading specialists. Also, the university has invited international academic staff from the following countries: United Kingdom, Germany, Spain, Italy, Belgium, Poland and others.

The existing system of quality assurance has been replaced by a new, entirely European standard system.

Both the academic and administrative staff have been trained by European international experts, who recommended the introduction of innovative teaching and learning methods, the formation of a constantly updating system of curricula, focused on constant adaptation of curricula to both domestic and international labour market, including the involvement of local as well as foreign professors and other functioning specialists.

The university strategic development plan has been elaborated with the participation of international experts, which SEU will be leading for the next 7 years. It was particularly difficult to carry out this transformation during the pandemic, when the already turbulent situation turned even more volatile and unpredictable. However, the university has managed to face all the challenges in a way to maintain its core value of student-centeredness, manifested not only in financial incentives and deferrals but the donation of more than 1400 Lenovo laptops to its students, to make sure the online learning to run smoothly and flawlessly.

The successful operation of SEU was confirmed on June 10, 2021, when the university was granted unconditional authorization. SEU received the highest evaluation from Georgian and foreign experts, while the existing achievements were recognized as best practices.

Currently, SEU provides 4 faculties and 18 accredited (undergraduate, graduate, one-step) educational programs in Business, Law, Social Sciences, Tourism and Medicine, with up to 8000 students and 500 academic and invited staff. The university takes great care of the development and elaboration of new educational programs in the direction of Business Technologies, Education, Public Administration and others.







FACULTY OF BUSINESS AND TECHNOLOGY

The Faculty of Business and Technology is one of the fastest growing faculties at Georgian National University SEU. The faculty offers undergraduate and graduate programs based on international standards, which provide full knowledge in the fields of business administration, tourism, finance, management, banking, human resource management and education administration.

The faculty offers students exchange programs to international universities. The faculty organizes international student and scientific conferences, summer schools, webinars and workshops, intended to help the students develop practical skills and be competitive in the local and international labor markets.

The learning process established in each program additionally includes practices and real-life projects.

It should be noted that the Faculty of Business and Technology is led by highly qualified Georgian and foreign, functioning lecturers with in-depth knowledge relevant to the requirements of local and international labor markets.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (ENG/GEO)

Georgian National University SEU offers a Georgian and English-medium Bachelor of Business Administration Program. The program is designed with the best practices and business environment in mind, thus fully responding to modern trends and technological progress. Demand for Business Administration graduates is high in both the Georgian and international labour markets.

The goal of the program is to provide competitive specialists with a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree, who will be able to contribute to the development of the businesses already operating in the market and make successful evidence-based business decisions. Deep knowledge of the theoretical and practical aspects of managerial activity, as well as the skills necessary for a professional career, will assist them in their successful employment. The graduates of the program will also possess all the skills needed to realize a business idea in real settings.

The graduates of the program will be able to be employed in various private or public sectors at managerial or middle positions, start their own businesses and develop innovative ideas.

FINANCE

The mission of the Georgian National University SEU Bachelor of Finance Program is to coach competitive specialists in the labour market, equipped with modern knowledge and skills in the field of Finance, using modern teaching methods and strengthening the practical component.

The concept of the program is based on the analysis of recent developments in the field, including the reforms and regulations imposed by the state, the needs of the private sector in the market and labor market requirements, as well as the expected challenges in the field.

The program aims to provide students with extensive theoretical knowledge in the field of Finance and its main areas such as accounting and auditing, corporate finance, tax administration and tax compliance, financial management, control and reporting; to develop logical thinking, teamwork and managerial skills in order to solve the relevant tasks while performing the functions of financial management.

MANAGEMENT

The aim of the Georgian National University SEU Bachelor of Management Program is to provide students with the knowledge about the principles of business operation, the behaviour of economic agents and the regularities of the economic environment; to equip them with theoretical knowledge and practical skills regarding the operation of the organisation; to develop managerial thinking to deal with oneself, the organisation, certain activities in the global environment, relationships and changes.

Under the program, the students will learn the principles of implementation and management of various functions of the organisation, the features and approaches of management in a multicultural environment, the importance of quality standards, modern technologies and innovations in the modern business environment, and ways to successfully put them in practice; to be introduced to the management features of organisations of different sizes and organisational design, methods of analysis of internal and external environment for the implementation of strategies in different types of markets; to master the methods and features of project management.

The program is focused on developing the ability of the student to communicate in the business world and use modern technologies in the process; to develop managerial thinking to deal





with oneself, the organisation, certain activities in the global environment, relationships, and changes.

The students undergo practical activities at partner companies or through business simulations. The practical activities with business simulations involve an innovative approach, requiring the students to complete 105 practical assignments to enhance their post-graduation awareness of a real business environment.

TOURISM

The aim of the Georgian National University SEU Bachelor of Tourism Program is to prepare competitive, highly qualified bachelors in tourism, oriented on democratic and humane values, who will be equipped with relevant knowledge and practical skills necessary for working in the field of Tourism, as well as the awareness of modern social-economic systems.

The aim of the program is to introduce students to the current state of the world tourism industry and prospects of development; the role and importance of the tourism industry, both nationally and globally; management and sectoral structure of the tourism industry, the mechanism of formation of consumer values of the tourism market, the current state of the world tourism industry and sustainable development trends and prospects; also, to provide the students with the necessary knowledge, skills and competencies to develop a tourism product independently and to become a competitive specialist.

The program is aimed at students to study the management of tourism enterprises, to develop the deep knowledge of tourism-recreational resources, environmental and cultural heritage sites for tourism purposes in the system of modern social and economic relations, and theoretical as well as practical skills necessary for providing tourist services.



The head office of Discover Georgia, the largest and most successful travel company in Georgia, is located on the SEU campus, offering the SEU students a unique chance to master the profession and enhance the theoretical knowledge gained at the university with a practical component.

The aim of the laboratory is to strengthen the practical component of the undergraduate educational programs (Tourism) carried out at the faculty.

TECH AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP LAB

- Within a dynamic and flexible university ecosystem, the Tech & Entrepreneurship Lab provides assistance to university beneficiaries in initiating startups. The lab services are completely focused on the activities necessary for the development of the startup;
- The lab services form a single, unbroken chain, starting from the inception and development of a startup idea, to shaping the final product, entering the market and commercialization;
- Promoting the development of startup ideas, the Tech & Entrepreneurship Lab:
- Offering university beneficiaries incubation / acceleration programs tailored to the needs of their startups;

- Helping the beneficiaries of the university to obtain the necessary financing for the development of a startup product, and to participate in the relevant grant programs;
- Promoting the development of entrepreneurial skills and bolstering strategic relations between scientific circles and businesses;

THE AIM OF THE SEU MBA IS TO PROVIDE A NEW TYPE OF MANAGER

Achieving the following objectives will produce:

- A new type of manager who is not necessarily an expert in narrow specialty but is aware of the interconnected nature of all problems. Who, in a systemic way, can identify problems, interpret and assess the quality of data, critically reflect on situations, develop and implement plans and, using the knowledge of best current practices, resolve problems.
- A new type of manager who is aware of differences of the 21st century for the need of operating and communicating in a global environment and dealing with the challenges of existing ecosystems, environments and social dimensions that every organization must address.
- A new type of manager who understands that the aspirations and practices of the workforce have changed, creating a more value-based working environment in constant communication with others. This requires new type of leadership, which is more people centric.
- A new type of manager who believes that learning is a lifelong endeavour and is constantly improving and aspiring towards excellence.

KEY MILESTONES OFFERED BY MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM:

A new master's program in Business Administration in response to the changing situations, preparing students for employment in "Flexible" companies. It has three main cores, namely:

- Organizational structure
- Operational excellence
- Systems thinking

Organizational structure means influencing the behavior of employees. In a poorly organized organization, the behavior of employees will not be good. Having a positive result indicates the existence of a good structure. Our study of organizational structure implies a positive outcome for a well-structured company.

Systemic analysis implies a holistic approach, i.e. seeing the whole picture and not its parts. It is necessary to see the relationship of the parts. Systems thinking involves seeing the connections between different events, not just perceiving events.

The three cores of the course mentioned also touch on the problems of the future, such as climate change, the depletion of world resources, the replacement of oil and gas with alternative energy sources, and the change in the supply chain that is happening right now.

Our graduate program always strives for excellence. Sunflowers need strong roots and good soil to grow. Our roots are our thinking, and the soil is our organizational structure. And our courses act as fertilizers, which nourish our three cores, and overall we get a strong, organic, flexible, growing course that always seeks the sun. I think this is truly a unique Master of Business Administration program.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

The first year consists of twelve main courses (60 ECTS), the third semester includes the student's specialization (Electives – 30 ECTS), and the fourth semester will be devoted to master's thesis. The third and fourth semesters of the second year, the student will be able to study at an international university and, along with taking the courses considered by the curriculum, will also obtain an international degree.

- Analysing global and market trends to discover, research and explore new business opportunities considering global ecosystem, development trends in production, supply and trade;
- Tackling day-to-day operation problems, facilitating operational excellence, using a variety of performance indicators and implementing operational change;
- Developing and implementing business growth strategies to achieve operational excellence, enhanced communication, engagement of human personnel and improved market position;
- Forming and developing strategic procedures and policies, tracking legislation changes, interpreting external reports and seeking ways of improvement of the operations, communication and partnerships;
- Using and interpreting different performance indicators, estimating the employee morale and preparing the teams for planned and continual changes, ensuring their engagement in the operations and providing professional development opportunities;
- Employees new leadership management style that is an essential element of the corporate culture;
- Comprehending that learning is a never-ending process of life-long learning;
- Engaging in continual self-improvement.

EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION

The SEU Master of Education Administration Program aims to provide professionals with diverse knowledge of education administration, who will be aware of modern, international (Western) standards in the field of Education, as well as being equipped with theoretical knowledge and practical skills for the development of the education system; also, involving the synthesis of education and modern, leadership-based managerial activities together with education, pedagogical, psychological aspects and contemporary challenges (globalisation, internationalisation, inclusion, etc.).

The program focuses on the challenges in the field of education, related to the development of intellectual capital of the educational institution, optimization of managerial and economic activities, upgrading of quality assurance systems, introducing modern methodological standards and management style, keeping the education system on a constant march towards perfection.



HUMAN RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

The SEU Master of Human Resource Management Program provides specialists with modern international knowledge, industry vision and practical skills, who can be fully trained to face the organisation's challenges such as organisational and human capital development, planning changes and innovation, and managing the performance indicators.

The program aims to develop modern visions and values in the field of Human Resource Management, and at the same time, to introduce and adopt certain specific tools.

The program is also distinguished by the fact that it equally incorporates teaching, research and practical components. Under the program, students enjoy the opportunity to engage in the planning and implementation of real consulting projects.

Graduates of this Master's program will be able to hold managerial profile positions both in the public and private sectors.



BANKING

The SEU Master of Banking Program prepares specialists with the ability to meet the growing demand for highly qualified personnel in the credit and banking sector, equipped with the theoretical and practical skills needed for the monetary and financial field, as well as being competitive in both the domestic and foreign markets.

The program is based on the ECTS principle and provides the opportunity to form a student-centered academic profile, as well as a combination of teaching, practical, and research components.

The aim of the program is to bring the student as close as possible to the practical activity. To this end, the program actively uses the university-based banking laboratory and other activities, which include memoranda of cooperation with public and private sectoral organisations in the relevant field.

Graduates of the Master's program will be able to hold managerial positions in government agencies (National Bank of Georgia, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Economy and Sustainable Development, etc.) and/or commercial banks, microfinance organisations, international entrepreneurial and consulting firms.

FACULTY OF LAW

The Faculty of Law of Georgian National University SEU is one of the largest faculties in the Georgian educational market, offering undergraduate and graduate programs to students. It should be noted that the Faculty is a member of the European Law Faculties Association of ELFA.

The faculty includes unique educational courses designed specifically for SEU in line with the best international experience and the requirements of the modern market, and combines both theoretical and practical components.

The Faculty of Law is led by key specialists in the field: judges, prosecutors, notaries and lawyers, majority of whom has been educated in universities around the world and actively share international experience with students in the teaching process. The academic staff is actively involved in law-making activities, as well as providing international legal expertise.

Law students take internships at SEU's state-ofthe-art legal clinic, as well as at partner law firms. SEU has a mock courtroom where students conduct mock trials.

Additionally, students participate in exchange programs, summer schools and student conferences, both local and international competitions.


LAW

The content of the SEU Undergraduate Program in Law is completely different from other current undergraduate programs, as evidenced not only by the structure of the program but the diversity of the teaching courses as well. The program offers several completely new academic disciplines that have been developed for this very program. In this regard, it is worth mentioning the following directions in the field of human rights, energy law and environmental issues, sports law and other teaching courses. The compulsory component of the program includes a course in practical skills and professional ethics, led by experienced practicing lawyers and implemented within the SEU Legal Clinic.

Graduates of the program are guaranteed, along with the knowledge necessary for employment, to acquire professional practical skills that will help them become successful lawyers.

Graduates of the program could be employed in legislative and executive, judicial, law enforcement and other regulatory bodies, legal entities of private or public law, or other non-profit (non-commercial) organisations on the position of legal profile, where

the academic degree of Bachelor of Laws is required and the law does not require taking the state certification exam or additional preconditions provided by the legislation of Georgia.



LAW

The SEU Master of Laws Program focuses on establishing and upholding legal values recognised by the national as well as international community.

The Master's program is aimed at providing the graduate with the knowledge of modern legal relations and the practical skills necessary for a lawyer to have the ability to act in accordance with the ethical norms of justice and various legal professions, human rights, social and democratic values.

The unique learning components of the program ensure that the student is provided with in-depth and systematic knowledge in the fields of private, criminal, public or international law, generalising best national and international case law and/or using comparative legal methodology.

The program is distinguished by the uniqueness of the research component, which aims to equip the student with modern methods of research of problematic issues within the Law and other related disciplines.

The graduate has the opportunity to work in any position where the degree of Master of Laws is required, and it is not necessary to take the state certification exam and/or additional preconditions provided by the legislation of Georgia.

SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE TITLED "EUROPEAN GREEN DEAL AND ITS POLITICAL, LEGAL AND ECONOMIC IMPACT ON GEORGIA"

On February 10-11, 2022 the European Integration Research Center of Georgian National University SEU hosted an international scientific conference titled "European Green Deal and its Political, Legal and Economic Impact on Georgia".

CONFERENCE ON "DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AS A SOCIAL CHALLENGE"

SEU hosted the international conference on "Domestic Violence as a Social Challenge" on April 11, 2022.

The conference was organized in the framework of the international research project - "MOVETIA" (Swiss National Agency for Exchange and Mobility) in partnership with Eastern Switzerland University (OST) and focused on the problems and challenges of domestic violence both in Georgia and Switzerland.

The representatives from the Government of Georgia, the Prosecutor' Office, the non-governmental sector, experts in the field and professors of SEU and OST delivered speeches at the conference. The international conference was held with the support from the USAID Rule of Law Program in Georgia.









LEGAL AID CLINIC

SEU operates a Legal Aid Clinic, where law students, within their authority and the supervision of public attorneys, provide free legal advice to individuals and assist them in preparing legal documentation.

This additionally enables the SEU students to practice and develop professional skills with real clients in real settings.

FACULTY OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

The Faculty of Social Sciences of Georgian National University SEU is focused on preparing competitive specialists in journalism, international relations, psychology, social psychology and clinical psychology. The Faculty of Social Sciences, in the process of teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels, allows for the international standards and the experience of international universities.

The faculty offers students exchange programs, internships and opportunities to participate in scientific student conferences and trainings, designed to help them develop important professional skills in parallel with their studies. Students are involved in research activities, thus contributing to the development of the University's interdisciplinary, multidisciplinary, and transdisciplinary research.

Both Georgian and English literature is used in the teaching process, which is in line with the requirements of the labor market. Functional lecturers use modern and innovative methods, which makes the teaching process more interesting and develops the student's ability in the field of social, psychology, international relations, analysis of current events and processes.

JOURNALISM

The aim of the SEU Bachelor of Journalism Program is to prepare competitive, qualified functional journalists for the modern media market, who will have knowledge of civic values and practical skills based on professional standards, relevant to working in the modern media industry.

The academic process of the program is practiceoriented, encouraging students to become more active in acquiring knowledge and professional skills, to master the principles of communication and work in the media industry.


Under the program, the students will learn about the role of media in modern society, issues of journalistic ethics and responsibility; gain knowledge concerning the professional standards, functions and principles of journalism and master professional skills.

Graduates of the program will be able to get employed in print media (newspapers, magazines), broadcast media (radio, television), Internet media, news agencies, public or business relations and press services of the state or business organizations, non-governmental sector, etc.



- The university operates a publishing house, which provides educational magazines and newspapers to be printed.
- The university accommodates a media laboratory equipped with modern infrastructure, giving the students the opportunity to acquire and refine practical skills. The equipment in the media laboratory allows teaching a practical component, including photo and video recording, editing, producing TV and radio stories, etc.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS



PSYCHOLOGY

The SEU Bachelor of Psychology Program aims to provide the student with the necessary theoretical knowledge in the field of psychology both in general and its individual components, considering the current challenges in the field of psychology in the context of the Georgian labour market, as well as to develop their practical and basic research skills.

The program provides the student with the opportunity to choose the desired field concentration (social psychology, clinical psychology, labour and organisational psychology, educational and developmental psychology) and to deepen their knowledge in this area. The concentration includes field professional practice and bachelor's thesis in the chosen field.

Graduates of the program will be able to get employed in any public or private institution, the effective functioning of which requires the knowledge in psychology. Probable employment areas include hiring as a psychologist at a small organization and as an assistant psychologist or specialist at medium and large organizations, according to the chosen sub-field.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

The aim of the SEU Bachelor of International Relations Program is to prepare highly competent and civilly responsible international relations specialists, who will be competitive with the demands of the labour market.

The program focuses to develop the students' field knowledge by providing them with international relations and policy aspects of the three regions (East, West, and Post-Soviet area), through the field-related internship in the same field and by completing a bachelor's thesis. The program focuses on the development of thinking and skills focused on the state and contemporary global challenges.

Under the program, the students will be introduced to the main trends and currents in the theory of international relations, diplomatic, legal and economic mechanisms for the regulation of relations between states, key aspects of international politics and globalisation; the importance of Georgia's place and role as a small state in the international system; the ability to analyze current processes in the field of international relations, communication, civic and



political thinking. Based on the acquired knowledge, the graduates of the program will be able to continue their studies at a master's level and/or be employed in Ministry of Foreign Affairs, international intergovernmental and non-governmental organisations, an international organisation accredited in Georgia, public institutions and private companies.

The three concentrations included in the program (in the form of East, West and Post-Soviet region) give the student more opportunities to choose the region of their interest and to specialise in that field.

SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY

The goal of the SEU Master of Social Psychology Education Program is to prepare highly competent psychologists in the broadest field of psychology, namely social psychology.

The aim of the master's program is to teach the student the general and specific patterns of human interaction with society, the important issues of the functioning of the group as a social formation, to introduce the patterns of human impact of different social roles and normative systems.

The program provides in-depth and systematic study of theoretical foundations, specific strategies and ways to use them adequately; mastering the principles of optimal interaction with the human social environment.

Graduates of the program will be able to be employed in public and private entities, engaging into research and socio-psychological counseling.







CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

The aim of the SEU Master of Clinical Psychology Program is to prepare a specialist in full accordance with modern requirements, which will be able to carry out clinical intervention and psycho-counseling within their competence.

The Master's program is focused on the development of practical skills, and all the inclusive courses contribute to the development of skills for the graduate in the direction of the practical component.

The basic concept of the program is to provide the student with an in-depth understanding of the importance of modern clinical psychology, the basics of the therapist-client professional ethics, to properly select personality research methods and strategies for psychological intervention in the field of psycho-social and psychological health. Graduates of the program will be able to be employed in public and private organisations and institutions where the qualifications of clinical psychologist and psycho-consultant are required.



PSYCHOLOGICAL COUNSELING AND TRAINING CENTRE



SEU operates a Psychological Counseling and Training Centre, which provides services and counseling to SEU students in the following areas: overcoming stress, anxiety, depression, phobias, various behavioural or emotional disorders, learning difficulties, strained relationships and conflicts, as well as developing leadership skills in personal growth and self-realisation, raising the level of financial and psychological well-being, and achieving success and career advancement.

The Centre helps psychology students to develop practical skills.



FACULTY OF MEDICINE

The Faculty of Medicine allows citizens of any country of the world to receive a quality education in the healthcare field.

The Faculty of Medicine administers an MD program in the English language (360 ECTS credits) accredited by National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement. Respectively, the program meets the ENQA and WFME standards.

The Faculty of Medicine is a member of the Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) and the Association of Medical Schools in Europe (AMSE) and has signed memoranda of cooperation with universities and medical clinics around the world.

In addition to the academic education, the students of the faculty are involved in extracurricular activities.

The teaching process at the faculty is led by recognized specialists in the field, local and foreign professors.

Auditoriums and laboratories equipped with modern technologies support the teaching of basic disciplines of the educational program. In the simulation lab, students develop practical skills working with simulators and dummies. Practical training in clinical disciplines is held in the leading clinics and medical institutions of Georgia.

The faculty provides the opportunity for students to take internships in foreign (US, UK, Turkey, Italy) medical clinics during the winter and summer holidays.

It is planned to build a university clinic and student dormitory with modern standards in the nearest future.










MEDICINE (ENGLISH-TAUGHT)

The programme aims at providing the graduates with necessary knowledge and competences relevant to the national and international standards. of the field that will ensure their further study in professional direction; assure with the modern, deep, systemic and integrated knowledge of biomedical, preclinical, clinical sciences and its application into practice; facilitate their motivation for continuous improvement of their knowledge and life-long learning; develop interpersonal, clinical skills, decision making based on the evidence-based data, understanding clinical cases in broad social, cultural contexts to promote health, wellbeing and prevent diseases, understanding of a physician's professional, ethical and legal responsibilities and contribute to the field development in the constantly changing environment.

A graduate has the right to:

- Complete a postgraduate vocational training programme (or the relevant vocational programme abroad recognized by the country in concern) and acquire the right to perform an independent medical practice after passing a state certification examination;
- Continue education at the third level of higher education system – doctoral level;
- Carry out research and teaching activities in the theoretical fields of medicine or other fields of health care that do not include an independent medical practice;





 Be employed as a Junior Doctor under the responsibility of an independent medical practitioner.



MASTER'S STUDENTS TOOK PART IN SUMMER SCHOOL TO SWITZERLAND

Master's students of Georgian National University SEU took part in summer school to Switzerland, organized by MOVETIA, Swiss national agency for the promotion of exchange and mobilty.

They visited St. Gallen Univeristy. The project was led by Vice-Rector Anna Phirtskhalashvili and the students were mentored by an invited expert Nia Dzeria.

Reminding that SEU, together with Swiss, Ukrianian and Albanian partner universities, is involved in the international project of MOVETIA, intended to both develop and implement a joint educational course titled "Human Rights, Social Challenges and Social Work" as well as organizing student research projects. As part of the visit, the participants assessed the social challenge-related research results.

The summer school was fully funded by MOVETIA. It should be noted that cooperation among the participating nations has further deepened and future joint projects have been outlined as well, including bilateral cooperation. Internalization remains top on SEU agenda and our students will be able to enjoy taking part in similar international projects in the future.





research activities should have a significant impact on a variety of outcomes, including public policy, law, social and economic, cultural or environmental outcomes.



SEU takes a great care of its students to make their learning process more comfortable and easier.











